StarHub Launches Commercial Pilot for 'Super Wi-Fi'

StarHub, together with two other founding members of the Singapore White Spaces Pilot Group, has announced the first series of commercial pilot deployments of TV White Spaces (TVWS) smart radio technology in Singapore. This initiative could potentially introduce a new class of wireless connectivity to Singapore, putting it at the forefront of a new wave of wireless services innovation and Smart City applications. The explosion of wireless data traffic growth has put a severe strain on mobile and Wi-Fi network infrastructure, signalling the need for more efficient management of spectrum. TVWS radio is one such innovation that turns unused TV broadcast frequency bands ("TV White Spaces") into premium wireless broadband delivery channels. >>
